Cllr Enticknap reported that he had met with Joe Court and approx 50 Ash trees have been marked in Mill Lane, Wrotham Hill, Chapel Hill, Knightons Lane and behind the cricket pitch. He further reported that there may be some money left from the last clearance that can be used towards the costs of removing the identified Ash trees.

Cllr Enticknap has identified Tilhill Forestry to possibly do a tree inspection - meeting to be arranged.

### 6. LOCALISM PROGRAMME

The Clerk reported that the bid for the £3.5k funding had been submitted.

### 7. WOODLAND AND POND MANAGEMENT PROGRAMME

Cllr Enticknap reported that a quote to clear the Grattons Pond this summer would be presented at the next meeting.

The grill for the culvert at the School Pond will be arriving and installed on Friday.

The cricket car park levelling is still outstanding.

Cllr Martin reported that the invasive plants need to be treated in May. Cllr Martin to follow up with the Forestry Commission.
