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1. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

None. Mr Bentall not present.

2. MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS MEETING

The draft minutes of the meetings held on the 14th May 2020 meeting as circulated, were proposed by Cllr Field; seconded by Cllr Enticknap and unanimously agreed as a true record for the Chairman to sign.

3. MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES

Item 4 January 20 - Footpaths. Preferred route found and marked up on a map. Cllr Gray to forward to Matt Lank, Waverley Borough Council, for initial discussion regarding the footpaths from the bus shelter to the doctors.

Item 6 March 20 - Cricket pitch scalping outstanding.

Item 6 March 20 - Springfield site - Cllr Gray reported that he had spoken to Matt Lank WBC and the planning officer of the Springfield site who says it is a matter for the DPC as it is on our leased land.

Item 6 May 20 - Cllr Enticknap reported that the bonfire remains have now been removed.

4. REPORT FROM THE CHAIRMAN OF THE STEERING GROUP

Nothing to report.

5. COMMONS CUT

It was AGREED that the commons management plan be reviewed. It was discussed to have sections 6,7,& 8 cut but not collected. It was further discussed that adders had been spotted and are a protected species. The alternative of leaving the common until a full cut and collect was also discussed. It was RESOLVED by a vote of 4 to 3 that the common be fully cut and collected at the end of August/beginning of September.

6. S106 MONIES

It was reported that £21486 had been received from WBC - £10k being for initial tree works around the Gratton Chase woodland entrance. The remaining is for maintenance works over the next 10 years. It was AGREED that Cllrs Hayward, Houghton and Enticknap meet with the Waverley ranger to discuss a schedule for the initial works. Cllr Hayward to arrange with the Waverley ranger.

7. WOODLAND AND POND MANAGEMENT PROGRAMME

It was reported that the Gratton pond on Shoppe Hill is full of grass.

8. COMMON AREA ISSUES

Nothing to report.

There being no further business, the Chairman closed the meeting at 8.00pm. The next Commons Committee meeting will be held on 10th September 2020 at 7.30pm.
