"The Group will report monthly to the Parish Council setting out progress on its work." "The Parish Council will approve the Submission Draft Neighbourhood Development Plan prior to publication for consultation and independent examination..." He further confirmed that the full council had agreed the engagement of Nexus at the council meeting in October.

Cllr Gray withdrew the motion as the proposer, Cllr Cookson-Taylor seconded this.

Cllr Jones declared he would abstain from voting.

After further discussion councillors concluded that no actions were required under the motion and decided not to formally vote on such a motion.
