Here is an update of what the Council has been doing since last month.

Thames Water Tankers

Thanks to all residents who have responded to the Council's request for evidence of disturbance caused by the constant stream of tankers working in the village. We have submitted a formal letter of complaint to Thames Water, which they have acknowledged and are in the process of formulating an official response. At the time of writing, the pumping activity has ceased and a storage tank has been installed on the site, which will store any future excess effluent.

If your personal property has been damaged by the tankers, please contact the Clerk who can provide a form to claim for recompense from Thames Water. Thames Water has agreed to repair damages to the verges etc on Common land.

Dunsfold Parish Council is working with Alfold Parish Council, which has been experiencing similar issues, to meet with Thames Water in order to try to address not only the current issues, but also to discuss long term infrastructure concerns.

Jeremy Hunt MP and local councillors Kevin Deanus and Jane Austin have all been very supportive.

Dunsfold Speedwatch

The local coordinator Catherine is stepping down from her role, but has been unable to find anyone else to take her place. Unfortunately, this means that Speedwatch will no longer be out and about in the village until a replacement can be found.

Speedwatch operates between March and October. The coordinator draws up a weekly rota for the volunteers, who spend an hour out in the village as a team of two, monitoring the speed of vehicles. This data is then passed on to the police. The coordinator also liaises with the police if there are any issues.

If you think you could take on the coordinator role, or join the band of volunteers when Speedwatch is up and running again, please contact the Clerk. Training is given.

In the meantime, we would like to thank Catherine for her years of service to the community.
