Remembrance Sunday

The Chairman of the Council, David Griffiths, laid a wreath on behalf of the Council in memory of all those who gave their lives in conflict, especially those named on our War Memorial.

Dunsfold Pond Regeneration Project

We are awaiting quotes from specialist companies to carry out the works identified in the recent pond survey. We have also submitted several grant applications to assist us in funding the project; fingers crossed!

We are still keen to set up a volunteer group to assist us with monitoring the ponds in the future, and perhaps carrying out some of the work under the supervision of experienced wildlife wardens. If this is something you are interested in, please contact the Clerk.

Old School Site

A reminder that the Parish Council are holding a Public Meeting at 7.30pm on Tuesday, 25th November at the Winn Hall. Representatives from the Diocese of Guildford will be present.

This meeting will be followed up with a survey seeking the views of local residents as to the future of the site.

Dunsfold Neighbourhood Plan

The Council has agreed to fund administrative support from its consultants Urban Vision Enterprise which should assist in speeding up the process. It is hoped that the Plan will be out for consultation in June 2026.

It was pointed out that there is no information about the Plan on our website. It was on there, but was not very easy to find. The Clerk has created a new Neighbourhood Plan page accessible via the drop-down menu that has all the documents. She will be updating this regularly so that residents are kept informed.

A reminder that we will be sending out a Housing Needs Survey soon to all households; please complete this, as it provides valuable data for us to use as evidence for the Plan.
